

Col Anderson was unable to submit an article. According to my sources he enjoyed one to many adult beverages and this is what happened



As many of you may or may not be aware our Supreme Commander has had to go into the hospital


for some routine tests. Please keep SC Tigner in your prayers as he deals with this. I know he will be back on his feet again very soon!
