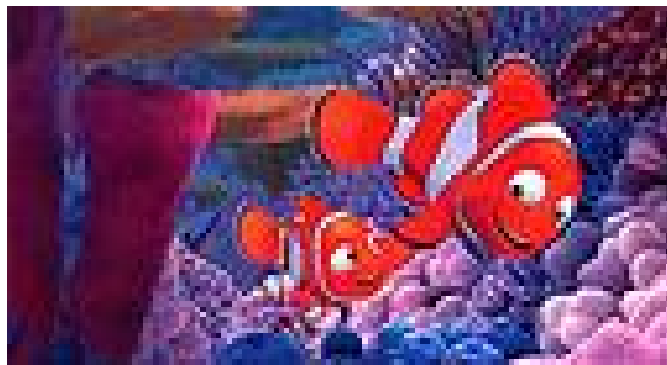

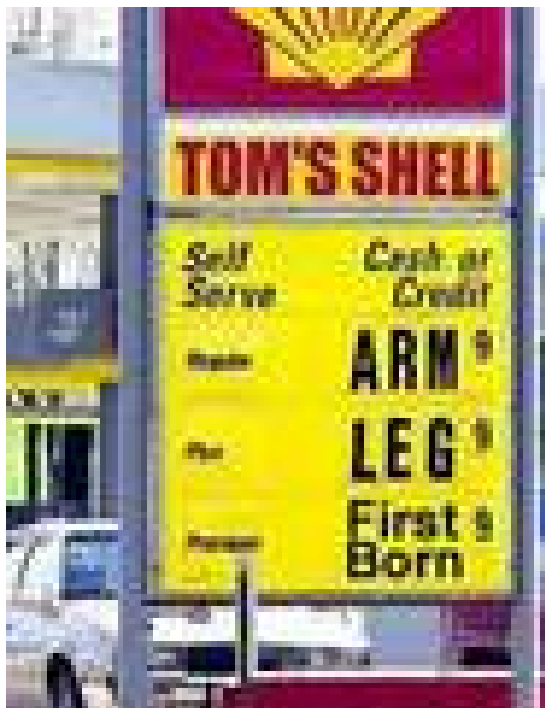

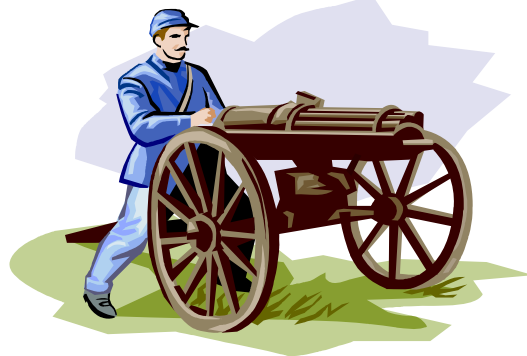
**"While the storm clouds gather far across the sea,
